### Postgate Rally 50th Anniversary

Today the Postgate Rally is at Ugthorpe, 2.30pm hymns followed by 3pm Mass. The preacher is Cardinal Arthur Roche. Bus leaves St. Gabriel's Church at 1.30 pm prompt. Please bring your own seating and refreshments.

Blessed Nicolas Postgate was born in 1598 at Egton at a time when Catholics were persecuted and fined for not attending protestant church services. Bl. Nicolas' mother was fined several times despite being a young widow. Priests travelled round the country in disguise; if caught they were hanged, drawn and quartered.

Nicolas Postgate travelled to Douai in France to train to be a priest, it was illegal in England.

After ordination he worked as a priest, administering the Sacraments in secret in Tadcaster, Holderness and Everingham. The last twenty years of his life were spent around Ugthorpe. He lived in poverty, serving the Catholics of the whole of the North Yorkshire moors from Cleveland to Pickering and Whitby.

In 1678 Nicolas Postgate was caught doing a Baptism, was arrested and sent to trial. On 7th August 1679, at the age of 83, he was martyred at the Knavesmire in York. Since his death local families have honoured him. In 1987 Pope John Paul II beatified him along with 84 other martyrs of these isles.

May Blessed Nicolas Postgate pray for us all and help all the priests and people of the diocese to live out the Faith fully without fear or compromise.

God our Father

In Blessed Nicolas Postgate you gave to your Church an example of faith  
And a willingness to live in poverty and humility for the glory of your name.  
Grant that like him we may grow daily in union with Christ in the Mass,  
And ponder on the mysteries of our salvation in the rosary.
