## Corpus Christi

The Feast of Corpus Christi began because one person saw that something so holy, and important in the life of every Catholic, should be celebrated. Her name was St Juliana, she was orphaned and brought up by nuns in Liege, Belgium. She joined the convent and from



a young age had a great devotion to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. She asked the bishop if a new feast could be celebrated in the diocese, what came to be the feast of Corpus Christi. Some years later one of the priests of that diocese became pope. He was so impressed by this idea of St Juliana that he gave the feastday to be celebrated throughout the Church and asked St Thomas Aquinas to write the prayers of the Mass. On this Feast day we can celebrate three aspects:

Thank God for giving us the Holy Mass which makes present on the altar the Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary. May we never miss an opportunity to go to Mass and especially encourage others to make it top priority each Sunday.

Thank God for giving us the opportunity to receive Jesus in Holy Communion so frequently. May we never take these graces for granted. Holy Communion is the food which gives us strength on our journey through life.

Thank God for the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the tabernacles of our churches.

There is a sign at the back of St Andrew's church which is worth highlighting:
