PUBLIC MASSES IN ST. ANDREW'S PARISH

We now have some public Masses each week and hopefully this can be extended in the future. This was allowed by the diocese after a risk assessment and plan was submitted, and stewards were recruited for each Mass. Masses are all at St. Andrew's Church on the following days:

Wednesday 10.30 am;

Friday 10.30 am;

Saturday 10.30 am;

Sunday 10.30 am.

Due to the 2 metre social distancing laws numbers are very much restricted with a maximum of 55 people allowed in the church at any one time. To help facilitate this a simple booking system is in place through our parish website, www.standrewsteesville.org.uk or for people who have no access to the internet you can book on a dedicated phonenumber 07756 443692.

On Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays I say a private Mass in the church for which you can still request a Mass intention in the normal way.

CONFESSIONS are each Saturday, 10.00 — 10.30 am before Mass. These take place in the Sacristy. Please let the stewards know that you would like to go to confession so they can show you to an appropriate seat. Thank you.

TO VOLUNTEER AS A STEWARD
