World Day of Prayer for Vocations.

Jesus says: I am the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for His sheep. As we see from the Gospels, He tries to prepare His Apostles to carry on His work after His Ascension into heaven. As He founded the Church and gave us the Sacraments, so He has called men in every generation to administer these Sacraments; to Baptise, to Absolve in Confession to Consecrate His Body and Blood and to Bless in His Name. He calls men to be priests, to be shepherds, to guide and protect, to lead his flock to green pastures, as Psalm 22 says.

Today the Church throughout the world prays for vocations, please make a special effort to pray for vocations for our diocese. As far as I know we have no students in training. This means no priests for the next seven years. The implications are obvious. Please pray also for the priests who have ministered to you throughout your life, both living and dead. Pray that our current priests will be faithful and not grow weary or give way to discouragement. Let us ask God's blessings on the priests who are celebrating jubilees this year. Those celebrating forty years of priesthood are Canon Eddie Gubbins (12th June), Mgr Gerry Dasey (22nd June), and Canon David Grant (20th November), Also Fr John Bane is celebrating twenty five years as a priest on 5th July. May God reward them for their years of service.

When Pope Benedict visited Britain he used the words of St John Henry Newman to all young people, that 'God has created us for some definite purpose'. Let us pray that our young men will, with your encouragement and prayers, consider being a priest. Pray also that young women will be open to the possibility of serving God in the religious life.

We are all called to serve God, either as married men and women, as priests, monks or nuns, religious brothers or sisters or single people. Let us pray that God will help us all to be generous and whole-hearted in our vocations and help others to find the path God wants them to follow.
